Betty Lou Jones, 86, died February 16, 2012, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles MO, with her close family at her bedside.

"Aunt Betty," a long-time resident of the Kansas City Northland, was a well-known local country comedienne. "Aunt Betty" produced and performed in several benefits and was a popular performer on numerous stages and Easter Seals Telethons during her more active years. Her last public performance was in the summer of 2010 at the age of 84.

Betty and her husband Frank were among the earliest part-time "settlers" in Golden Beach at the Lake and she always said "This place is my sanity." Betty was also very active in the Avondale Senior Citizen's Club and the Red Hatters in Gladstone.

She was born Betty Lou Campbell in Joplin, MO, to George William and Dessie Ida Lou (Presley) Campbell. Betty was preceded in death by Frank, her beloved husband of 50 years, and fourteen older brothers and sisters. Survivors include her son Frank Jones of Golden Beach (Kathi), her daughter Alicia Robertson of Gallatin (Rob); four grandchildren--Frank Jones (Angelia) of Boonville, Lisa Endsley of Polo, Jennie Brinkerhoff-Fay (John) of Kansas City, Ryan Brinkerhoff of Chicago IL, Chad Robertson of Gallatin, Amanda Robertson of Chillicothe, great-grandchildren and many close extended family

members.
