



Vernon "Bud" Nielsen

August 23, 1918 - February 17, 2012

Vernon "Bud" Nielsen, age 93, of Laurie, passed away Friday, February 17, 2012, at the Laurie Care Center. He was born August 23, 1918, in Rosedale, Kansas, the son of the late Charles and Emma Ericksen Nielsen.
