Reta Raylene Lehman, age 67 of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Thursday, January 10, 2019, in her home while surrounded by family.

She was born November 7, 1951, in Climax Springs, Missouri, to Raymond and Charlene (Park) Ollison. On November 18, 1972, at the First Baptist Church in Versailles, she was united in marriage to Warren Milton Lehman. Together they shared forty-six years of marriage and two children.

Reta was Secretary and Treasurer at Raymond's Boat and Motor Sales, Inc. of Gravois Mills, Missouri, which she owned with her family. She was very involved in local education, serving nine years on the Morgan County R-II Board of Education as well as president of the Gravois South PTO.
