John Alexander “Alex” Feik, age 89, of Versailles, passed away Monday, December 17, 2012, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born May 11, 1923, a son of the late Franz and Marie Montag Feik who migrated to the United States from the Czechoslovakian/Austrian border on September 22, 1920.
