



## Alfred Earl Vasey

May 15, 1931 - November 30, 2022

Alfred Earl Vasey, age 91, of Gravois Mills, passed away Wednesday, November 30, 2022, at his home. He was born May 15, 1931, in Kansas City, Missouri, son of the late Earl and Ina (Chaffin) Vasey.

On June 17, 1961, in Kansas City, Missouri, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Marilyn (O'Connor) Vasey.

Alfred served four years in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict.

He was an Executive for the Boy Scouts of America for over thirty years, serving in five different councils, and positively impacting thousands of lives.

Alfred was a member of the St. Patrick Catholic Church in Laurie where he was active in the Knights of Columbus. He was also an active member of the Osage Community Elks Lodge 2705 in Laurie, a member of the Zack Wheat Post 624 in Sunrise Beach and swam laps for many years at the Westlake Aquatic Center in Laurie.

He loved the Lake of the Ozarks and living in his home on the lake. Alfred enjoyed being outdoors hunting, fishing and boating.

In addition to his wife, Marilyn, he is survived by his sons, Steve Vasey and wife Valerie Hunter of Calgary, Canada, John Vasey and wife Becki Leitman of Loma, Colorado and Charles Vasey and wife Betsy Stephens of Marceline, Missouri; grandchildren, Elaine, India, John, Dale, Alison, Jackson and William; great-grandson, James; sister, Ina Faye Lewis of Lee's Summit and many other relatives and friends.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 a.m., Friday, December 9th, at the St. Patrick Catholic Church in Laurie with Father John Schmitz celebrating.
