Alice M. (Potter) Lockwood went to be with our Lord on Tuesday October 24, 2023.

She was a lifelong member of the First Lutheran Church. She was born September 10, 1928, in Galesburg, Illinois, where she lived for 89 years. She moved to Versailles, Missouri in 2017 to live with her daughter & son-in-law. She was the daughter of Howard Potter and Sophie (Carlson).

She married Leo D. Barbero in July 1950 and was blessed with 2 children of that marriage who both survive, daughter Kathleen (Kat) Boyd (Jim) of Versailles, Missouri and son David R Barbero (Mary), Betty Barbero (deceased) of Galesburg, Illinois. After 2 years of business college, she worked as the secretary to a professor at Knox College in Galesburg before getting married at age 21. She raised her children alone, by ironing for people. Once her children were grown, she became a secretary again at a local nonprofit agency assuring people in need received help with power bills or home repairs.

Alice enjoyed crocheting, reading, gardening, playing bingo with friends, rummi cube and watching tv. She was a great cook, and her pies were a family favorite.

A graveside service is planned in her hometown of Galesburg, Illinois, with family and friends. The date is to be determined.
