Richard Louis Amsinger, age 72, of the Golden Beach Community near Barnett, passed away Sunday, July 20, 2003 at his home. He was born August 6, 1930 in St. Louis, Missouri, the son of Clarence Roland and Isabel R. Staude Amsinger.
