Howard L. (Roy) Amundson, age 76, of Topeka, Kansas, and Gravois Mills, passed away Thursday, June 18, 2003 in Stover, Mo. He was born August 3, 1926 in Sisseton, South Dakota, the son of Lloyd and Freda Lauter Amundson.
