Barbara Ann (Thompson) Siebenmorgen, age 72, of Sunrise Beach, passed away Tuesday, January 24, 2012, at her home.

She was born August 15, 1939, in Fairmont, Minnesota, and grew up on a farm with her parents, Herman and Lucille Muth Thompson, near Rake, Iowa. There, she attended and graduated from Rake High School in 1957, with the honors of Salutatorian.
