Becky Jo LaRock-Derrington, 64, of Camdenton, Missouri departed this life on the early morning of Saturday, June 29, 2019. Becky was born December 30, 1954, in Kansas City, Kansas, the daughter of Howard “Bob” and Florence (Tattershall) Linkey.

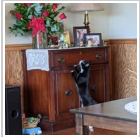
