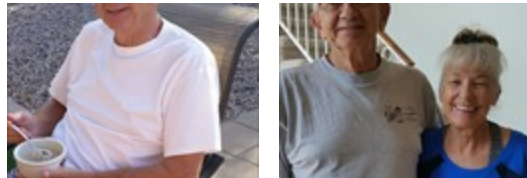

I'll see you when I get to the other side.*

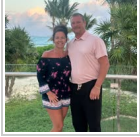
