Betty Jo (Hutchison) Huffman, age 96, of Versailles, passed away peacefully at her home on Saturday, December 30, 2023. Betty was born to Edgar “Cap” and Mary Josephine Newkirk Hamilton Hutchison on March 23, 1927, near Latham. She married Aubrey Lester Huffman on September 14, 1946. He preceded her in death on Jan. 19, 2022, following 75 years of marriage.

Betty worked at the Primo pants factory in Versailles and retired from Gates Rubber Co. She was a long-time member of Calvary Baptist Church, serving many years in the nursery, where she loved the children. Betty enjoyed gardening, canning and quilting, hand-stitching more than 50 quilts over the years. She was part of several quilting circles through the years, sharing laughs and stories with dear friends. She also raised registered dogs for many years, giving tremendous care to the puppies that people enjoyed in their homes. Betty loved nothing more than spending time with her family, and especially enjoyed large family gatherings that included her siblings and their families.

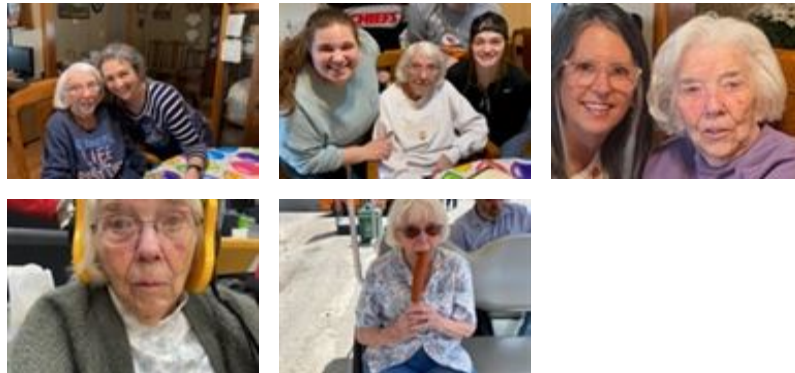
