



Beulah Faye (McMullin) Housworth

Beulah Faye (McMullin) Housworth died on February 29, 2020, after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. She had lived at California Care Center in California, Missouri for the past seven years.

Beulah was born on March 6, 1928, to Edwin and Myrtle McMullin in Blackwater, Missouri.

The family moved to Sedalia, Missouri where Beulah lived and attended school. She was the youngest of six children including, Naomi Price, Carl McMullin, Mary Ruth Yesson, Edna Wills and Charles McMullin.

Beulah married Glenn D. Housworth on Sept. 4, 1948, in Sedalia, Missouri, and they later moved to Versailles, Missouri where Glenn worked at the Morgan County Library and Beulah was a wonderful homemaker and mother.

Beulah and Glenn eventually established an antique store on the square in Versailles, Missouri known as Pastime Antiques, which came to be a well-known, thriving business for 13 years.

Through their married years, they enjoyed many wonderful friends and families in their home in Versailles, Missouri. Glenn preceded her in death in 2007.

Beulah is survived by her three children, Linda Cable and Connie Walker, both in California, Missouri, and Tom Housworth in Ocala, Florida, and also six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren and many friends and family.

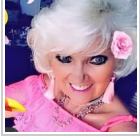
