William Rudolph “Bill” Rosche, age 92, of Gravois Mills, Missouri, passed away Thursday, July 28, 2022 at Lake Regional Hospital, Osage Beach, Missouri. He was born February 8, 1930 in Kansas City, Kansas, a son of Rudolph Frederick and Marie Wilhelmina (Hurrelbrink) Rosche.

On October 22, 1954, he was united in marriage to Evelyn Ruth Williams. To this union, two sons were born. They shared sixteen years of marriage before her passing on June 8, 1971. He married Clara Jean Seaton at Zion Church in Kansas City, Kansas on January 6, 1990. Together they have shared the past thirty-two years of marriage.

Bill was raised in Kansas City, Kansas and was a graduate of Washington High School in the class of 1948. He served his country proudly in the United States Army during the Korean War. After being honorably discharged, he returned to Kansas where he was a farmer for many years. He later began a career in heavy equipment operations and was a member of Local 101. He and Clara retired to the Lake of the Ozarks in 1997.

He was a member of West Lake Christian Church in Laurie, Missouri. Bill loved his church and especially the children. He was the “Mayor” of his lake

community and could often be found on his golf cart patrolling the neighborhood.

Survivors include his wife, Clara Rosche of the home; two sons, Kenneth Rosche and wife Kristen of Basehor, Kansas and Scott Rosche and wife Wendy of Lathrop, Missouri; two step-children, Angela Flores of El Dorado Springs, Missouri and Jim Parker and Billee of Kansas City, Kansas and numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his first wife, Evelyn Rosche and a brother, Ed Rosche.
