Billie June Hibdon, age 87, of Laurie, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, July 13, 2021 at Laurie Care Center, Laurie, Missouri. She was born March 3, 1934 in Camden County, Missouri, a daughter of William H. and Velma E. (Green) Patterson.

On November 21, 1953, she was united in marriage to Glen Everett Hibdon. Together they shared fifty-six years of marriage before his passing on June 19, 2010.

She was very proud to have recently received her 30-year belt buckle for attendance at the event. Most of all, spending time with her family brought her joy.

She was a long-time member of Ozark Chapel United Methodist Church in Laurie.

A graveside service and burial will be held at 3:00 p.m., Sunday, July 18, 2021 at Ozark Chapel Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 2:30-3:00 p.m. at the cemetery.

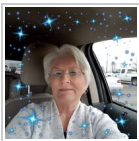
