



## Billy Ray Arment

October 31, 1939 - March 26, 2020

Billy Ray Arment, age 80, of Barnett, passed away Thursday, March 26, 2020, at his home. He was born October 31, 1939, in Kirksville, Missouri, a son of the late George E. and Hazel D. (Lindsey) Arment.

Billy was a United States Air Force veteran having served from 1957 to 1961.

He worked in maintenance for the State Highway Department for twenty-seven years until his retirement. Later, he served as the Eastern District Commissioner for six years and the Presiding Commissioner for two years in Morgan County.

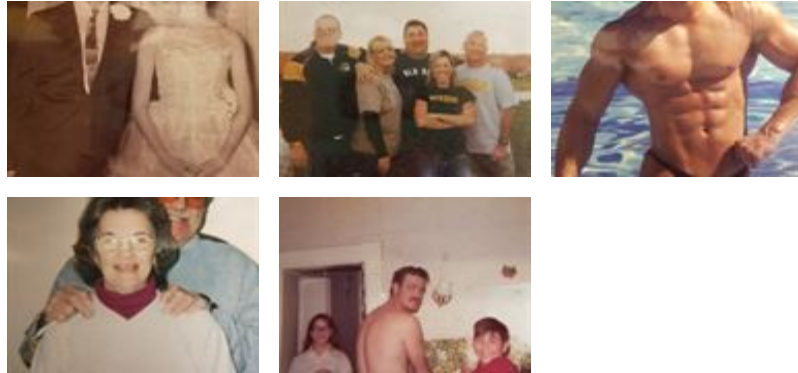

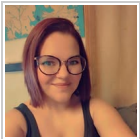

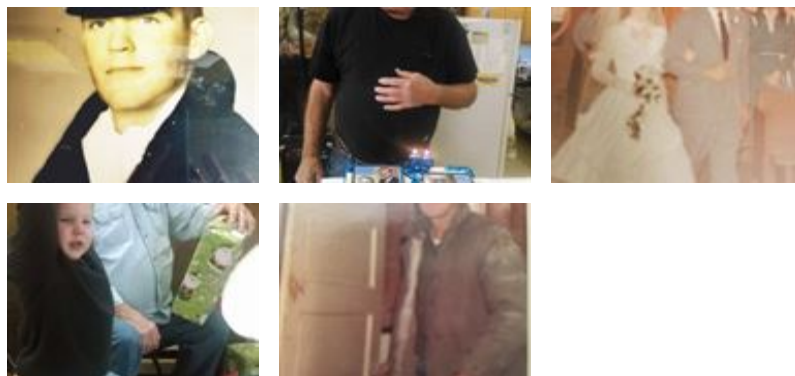
