Blake J. Cable, age 83, of Versailles, passed away Sunday, January 23, 2011 at Harry S. Truman Veterans Hospital in Columbia. He was born October 13, 1927 at Versailles, MO, a son of the late Blake B. and Maude R. Moore Cable.

He married Betty Sue Heineman on February 8, 1948 and she preceded him in death on May 5, 2006.
