



## Bob Manon

May 30, 1937 - January 20, 2022

Robert Ray “Bob” Manon, age 84, of Versailles, Missouri, passed away Thursday, January 20, 2022 at Audrain Community Hospital, Mexico, Missouri. He was born May 30, 1937 in Rock Island, Illinois, a son of the late Francis Paul and Frances Olive (Scanlan) Manon.

On January 11, 1964 in Galesburg, Illinois, he was united in marriage to Mary Lee Fry. Together they shared fifty-seven years of marriage before her passing on February 20, 2021.
