Jerry LeRoy Broadaway, 80, of Versailles, died Tuesday, April 15, 2003, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City.

He was born Nov. 6, 1922, in Jonesboro, Ark., a son of James LeRoy and Mary Butler Broadaway. On Aug. 5, 1950, in Eatontown, N.J., he was married to Anna Belle Hachler, who survives.

Mr. Broadaway served in the Army for 20 years. He worked in Federal Civil Service at Fort Leonard Wood from 1964 to 1978. He was a World War II veteran, receiving the Bronze Star, Good Conduct Medal, European Theater Medal with four bronze stars, Occupation Medal, Victory Medal, National Defense Medal and the Belgian Fourragere award. He was a Methodist and was an avid amateur radio operator. He was a member of the Morgan County Amateur Radio Emergency Service and the Military Amateur Radio Service.

He was predeceased by a brother, Eugene Callaway Brockaway.

Graveside services will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at Versailles Cemetery with military rites at graveside.
