Gladys Hagan Busch, 97, of Dothan, Ala., formerly of Versailles, died Tuesday, Jan. 7, 2003, at Flowers Hospital in Dothan.

She was born Jan. 28, 1905, in Morgan County, a daughter of Aubrey Arthur and Clara Ella Clark Hagan.

Ms. Busch lived in Versailles when she was young. She was a graduate of Versailles High School, William Woods College in Fulton and Central Missouri State Teachers College. She taught elementary and high school students for seven years. She later worked for the state of Missouri Division of Employment and Security for 27 years, before she retired. She moved to Dothan 20 years ago. She was a member of Covenant United Methodist Church, where a new United Methodist Circle was named in her honor in 2000.
