Robert William “Butch” Jarrett, Sr., 82, passed away on Tuesday, December 7, 2021, with his family by his side in North Kansas City, Missouri. Butch was born in Chicago, Illinois on July 29, 1939, but grew up in Kansas City and called Kansas City his home.
