Lester D. Cable, age 84, of Sedalia, formerly of Kansas City, MO, passed away Thursday, July 10, 2003 at Bothwell Regional Health Center in Sedalia. He was born May 19, 1919 in Brazil, Indiana, but grew up in Versailles, MO. Lester was the son of Maude R. Moore and Blake B. Cable.

He married Evelyn M. Aeschbacher on July 20, 1944 while serving in the U.S. Marine Corps.

Lester was a World War II veteran of the South Pacific including the battle of Guadalcanal. He worked as plant superintendent of Sinclair and Valentine Ink in Kansas City for 33 years after he was discharged from the Marines.

He is survived by his wife of the home; five children, Darwood Cable of Columbia, MO, Dianne Cable Schmitt of Natrona Heights, PA, Timothy Cable of Overland Park, KS, Barbara Cable Casey of Overland Park, KS, and Jeremy Cable of Grand Rapids, MN; seven grandchildren and two brothers, Clarence Cable and Blake Cable, both of Versailles, MO.
