Aubrey J. Calton, age 85, of Warsaw, formerly of Versailles, passed away Sunday, May 9, 2004 at Warsaw Health and Rehabilitation Center in Warsaw. He was born June 21, 1918 near Hurricane Deck, Missouri, the son of John Edward and Hattie Opal McCasland Calton.

He was united in marriage on March 16, 1945 in Kansas City, Kansas with Lela Dona Mace, who preceded him in death on October 20, 2002.

Aubrey was an Army veteran of World War II and a member of Calvary Baptist Church near Versailles. He was a deacon for several years and worked in the Morgan County Jail Ministry for over 26 years, giving away over 300 Bibles to the inmates. He retired from Kansas City Bifocal Plant in Versailles at the age of 62.
