Trustin C. Calton, 13, of Linn, died Saturday, March 15, 2003, at St. Mary's Health Center in Jefferson City from injuries suffered in a bicycle accident on U.S. 50 in Linn earlier that evening.

He was born Dec. 5, 1989, at University of Missouri Hospital and Clinics in Columbia, a son of Donald and Teresa Williams Calton.

Mr. Calton was baptized at Lakeside Community Baptist Church, where he was a lifetime member. He was a seventh-grader at Osage County Middle School in Linn. He enjoyed spending time with his friends and family, talking on the phone, attending karate classes and bike riding.

Surviving are his father of the home; his mother of Kansas City; two sisters, Gwen Calton and Miranda Schultz, both of Linn; a brother, Trevor Calton of Middletown; his grandfather, Aubrey Calton of Warsaw; two nieces; and three nephews.

He was predeceased by his grandparents, Keith and Jean Williams and Dona Calton.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Friday at West Union Baptist Church near Versailles with the Rev. Dallas Moritz and the Rev. Rod Campbell officiating.
