Carl William Tucker, age 92, of Laurie, passed away Friday, May 23, 2014, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born November 30, 1921, in Little Rock, Arkansas, a son of the late Floyd Abraham and Mary Helen (Peaslee) Tucker.

On May 9, 1942, in Conway, South Carolina, he was united in marriage to Pauline C. Haselden who preceded him in death on November 27, 2007.

Carl was a retired United States Air Force veteran serving 28 years and achieving the rank of Chief Master Sergeant. He served in World War II, the Korean Conflict and Vietnam.
