Cecil P. Tremblay, 95, of Sparta, WI died Tuesday, April 10, 2012 at Morrow Memorial Home, Sparta. He was born on May 26, 1916 in Holcombe, WI to Alexander and Magdalene (Russel) Tremblay.

Cecil grew up in Ladysmith, WI and graduated from Ladysmith High School. He went to work at the regional creamery and dairy plant in Ladysmith and also owned and worked on his family farm.

He married Veronica Ann McGlone on August 4, 1943 in Ladysmith. They lived in Ladysmith, started and operated an excavation business and later built and operated a small country store and fishing camp.

He then bought and ran a Ford dealership in Cornell. He eventually sold the dealership and farmed again in Bloomer, WI. He also worked at Presto Ammunition Plant in Eau Claire, WI. He retired in 1975, then moved to Missouri and started CSP Construction. He moved back to Wisconsin in 2007.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Brotherhood of Elks. He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed fishing, hunting, camping, boating, and taxidermy. He appreciated and respected all of nature.
