Charles Marvin Smith, Sr., age 85, of Gravois Mills, passed away on Thursday, June 4, 2015 at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles.

Charles was born on June 14, 1929, the son of the late Frank I. Smith and Lola (Campbell) Smith.

On September 29, 1954, Charles was united in marriage to Margaret Fern Shull. to this union, two sons and four daughters were born.

Charles was a Veteran of the United States Army and served in Korea. He took a shot to the leg from enemy fire and was Honorably Discharged. He received a Purple Heart metal for his courageous action. Charles was a hardworking man. He worked in construction in Sedalia for the Local 663. He enjoyed living on the lake, fishing, running trot lines and hunting. Charles had an ear for music and could play most any song on the guitar just by hearing it played. "Come to the Church in Wildwood" was one of his favorite songs to play. Charles was known by his family to be a "foot ticker", they would find out later that Charles was very ticklish himself.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Frank and Lola Smith; his wife, Margaret Fern Smith; one son, Frank Smith; two grandsons, Charles Michael Smith and Dustin Andrew Webb; along with all of his siblings which include

two sisters, Sharon and Mary; and five brothers, Don, Gene, Paul, Dean and Melvin.

Charles is survived by his four daughters, Lola E. Webb (Jimmy) of Versailles, Sharon Goad (Tom) of Stover, Codie A. Lemens (Ronnie) of Versailles and Lura C.
