Maj. Oda C. "Chuck" Miller, U.S. Army Ret., age 89, of Versailles, passed away Wednesday, October 1, 2014, at his home. He was born November 9, 1924, in Winslow, Arkansas, a son of the late Oda S. and Hattie Pearl (Guinn) Miller.

On August 22, 1952, in Kansas City, Missouri, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Winona V. (McCorkle) Miller.

Chuck was a World War II veteran retiring from the United States Army with the rank of Major.

He owned and operated Russell P. Hall Real Estate in Versailles for many years until his retirement.
