Clarence H. Cable, age 91, of Versailles, passed away Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at Captial Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. He was born March 23, 1917 in Pettis County near Beaman, MO, the son of Blake B. and Maude R. Moore Cable.

He was united in marriage on June 2, 1940 with Willena Ann Silvey who preceded him in death on June 21, 1994.

Mr. Cable was a retired store manager for 32 years prior to his retirement from Dillon's Supermarket. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II and member of the American Legion Post #104 in Versailles since 1947, and V.F. W. Post #5902 in Gravois Mills. He was a member of the Versailles United Methodist Church for 73 years, served on the Morgan County R-II School Board, the Versailles City Council, 50 year member of the Versailles Lions Club and was the Morgan County Fair Boards Purchasing Agent for 20 years. He was manager of the Versailles Merchants Baseball Team for 20 years.
