Clyde Lynn Lowe passed away Saturday, June 21, 2025, in the home he built in Gravois Mills, Missouri.

Clyde was born on June 8, 1951, to Patricia Ann (Triesky) and Clyde Cecil Lowe in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He graduated in 1969 from Central High School in Tulsa, OK, and later in life obtained his associate's degree from Johnson County Community College in Overland Park, KS.

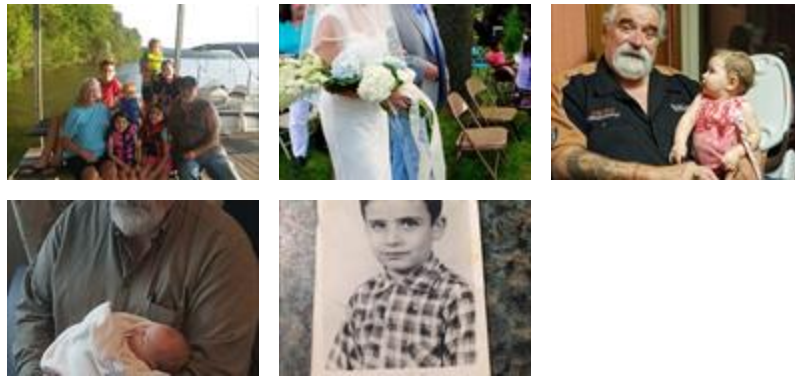
