



## Dale Brinkley "Brink" Arnold

Dale Brinkley "Brink" Arnold, of Osage City, Kan., passed away on Dec. 2, 2011 in Gravois Mills, Mo. at the age of 53. The son of Dale and Sue Arnold, Brink was born on August, 16, 1958 in Indianapolis, Ind.

He was united in marriage to his wife Karen on Dec. 28, 1985 in Manhattan, Kan.

Brink graduated from Osage City High School, served two years in the United States Navy, returned to graduate from Mid-America Nazarene College and extended his education at Kansas State University, where he met and married his wife, Karen.
