

## Daniel "Dan" Watts

August 25, 1962 - April 25, 2015

Daniel W. "Dan" Watts, age 52, of Roach, Missouri, departed this life on Saturday, April 25, 2015 at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City, Missouri.

Dan was born on August 25, 1962 in St. Louis, the son of Jess L. Watts and Jean (Doherty) Watts.

Dan was known by many names: "Daddy Dan" to his loving step children, Maria and Monica. "Popo" to his grandchildren, Frank and James whom he loved so much. "Dan" to his family whom he always helped. His father taught him as a child how to measure to the 1/16th inch and mentored him in welding, auto work, building, etc. "Dan the Tool Man" since he had most every tool Snap On sells. He and one of his best friends, Tom, put their heart and souls into their business (Highway 7 Workshop) where they worked on cars, golf carts, 4 wheelers, R.V's, docks, etc. "The Neighborhood Handy Man" a man of few words but helped everyone in need, he could not say "No".

"Captain Dan" Dan had been coming to the lake for most of his life. He bought a new runabout boat in 1987 (Moonshadow) and by 2014 he logged more than 10,680 hours by only using it on the weekends that he could travel from St. Louis, until he moved here in 2013. He was a captain of the household and the No Tell Floatel as well.

He will be missed by all who knew him, including his dog, Byou, who got his name because he was always right by you.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Watts of the home; two step-daughters, Maria Heavel (Keith) and Monica McCarthy (Kyle); two step-grandsons, Frank and James Heavel and one McCarthy baby on the way; his mother and step-father, Jean and George Stark; four siblings, Kitty Schaffer (Mike Waeckerle), Tom Watts (Joann), Rick Watts (Terri Tafra) and Barb Cecil (Tom); one great uncle, Buddy Watts; one uncle, Ed Doherty; three nephews, two nieces and multiple cousins.

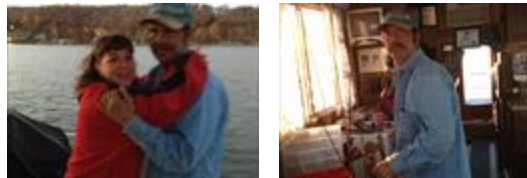
