Darlene M. Huffman, age 80, of Stover, passed away Friday, July 15, 2011, at her home. She was born October 13, 1930, in Stover, Missouri, the daughter of the late Jacob E. and Noma Rehmer Fry.

On April 2, 1950, at the Stover First Baptist Church, she was united in marriage to Raymond L. Huffman, who survives of the home.
