Bobby Gene Daulton, age 74, of Versailles, passed away Saturday morning, October 23, 2004 at the St. Marys Health Center in Jefferson City. He was born July 27, 1930 in Belton, Missouri, the son of Charley Chapman and Nealie Ellen Housworth Daulton.
