David Jay Holst, age 71, of Versailles, passed away Wednesday, September 25, 2019, at University of Missouri Hospital and Clinics in Columbia. He was born November 24, 1947, in Morgan County, Missouri, a son of the late Dorsey Holst and Janet (Davis) Holst.

David graduated from Morgan County R-II in 1967. He was an Air Force veteran from 1968-1972 with an honorable discharge.
