David Douglas Hutchison, age 98, of Boonville, passed away Tuesday, October 31, 2023, at Columbia Post Acute. He was born November 10, 1924, in Warrensburg, son of the late Edgar and Mary Josephine Newkirk Hamilton Hutchison.
