Dean Tuttle, age 54, of Tipton, passed away Sunday, September 18, 2011, at his home. He was born January 15, 1957, in California, Missouri, the son of Warren Eugene “Gene” and Leola Long Tuttle.

On March 21, 1998, in Tipton, he was united in marriage to Margaret Simmons, who survives of the home.

Dean was a 1975 graduate of the Tipton High School. He attended Midwest Technical School in Kansas City, Missouri, graduating in 1976.
