



## Dennis T. Garber

Dennis T. Garber, age 92, of Tipton, passed away at the Veteran's Home in Warrensburg, Missouri on September 9, 2016.

He was born on March 9, 1924, in rural Versailles, Missouri, the son of the late Edwin R. and Elizabeth Diener Garber. Also preceding Dennis in death are his siblings, Pauline Wulff, Violet Garber, William, Norman "Bud", Edwin, Bob and Raymond Garber.
