Hubert (Hugh) Frank Dial, age 93, of Sunrise Beach, passed away Tuesday, May 13, 2003 at Lake Regional Hospital in Osage Beach. He was born October 4, 1909 in Octa, Missouri, the son of Rufus Frank and Dixie Lebo Dial.

He was united in marriage in 1928 to Viola Amich, who preceded him in death. To this union four children were born. In 1941 he married Irene Elliott, and three children were born to that union.
