Donald Eugene Lurz, age 86, went to be with the Lord on December 16, 2019. He was surrounded by family and peacefully passed in hospice care at Windsor Estates, Camdenton, Missouri.

Don served in the United States Navy from 1951 to 1955 during the Korean War on the U.S.S. Towhee as an engine mechanic. He often referred to this as the best time of his life.

Don owned and operated Don Lurz Construction until he retired in the year 2000. Don thoroughly enjoyed

teaching his trade to the younger generation of which he trained many young men.

Don enjoyed fishing on the Lake of the Ozarks and passing that skill down to his daughters as he took them on many trips running his trot line, trolling for bass and seeing how many crappie they could catch off of one minnow. He also enjoyed teaching them to water ski and made countless right-hand turns pulling them skiing in Sagamo cove.

Once his family was grown, Don and Mary made countless trips to the Caribbean with family and friends. They left hundreds of pictures to share with family as a memory to the joy they experienced while traveling.

Don fiercely loved his family and could be found attending their many sporting events, dance recitals, birthdays and graduations. He especially loved all of his grandchildren and great-grandchildren and was proud of how many he had accumulated.

Don is survived by daughters, Debbie Carnahan and husband Tim and Cindy Slenker and husband Jerome all of Camdenton, Missouri; sister, Joni Roscoe of Big Rock, Illinois; six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren as well as many precious nieces, nephews and cousins.
