



Donna Mae Clark

With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of Donna Mae Clark, on March 27, 2025, beloved wife of Larry Clark, at the age of 82. She was born on December 6, 1942, in Springfield, Missouri, daughter of the late Thelma (Megert) Gollihar and Floyd Gollihar and sister of the late Wayne Gollihar.

Alongside her devoted husband Larry of 62 years, she raised three daughters, Lynn Garber, Wendy Timmons and Mitzi Pummer, and also cared for her own mother, all while helping run the successful family business, Gollihar's Shoe Store in Versailles, Missouri. Founded in 1952 and now called Sole Solutions, the store transferred to a third generation in 2018, run by Lynn and husband Steve.

Donna especially enjoyed the many years spent at their house on the Lake of the Ozarks. In her spare time, she was active in the Golden Beach Community Church. She loved her friends, boating, fishing and Taco Tuesdays.

An avid reader, shopper and Spider Solitaire player, Donna also found time for her community. She leaves a lasting legacy in Versailles, where she helped found the local daycare Children's House in 1973 and led the collection of donations for the local Rescue Squad's Christmas Toy Drive campaign for many years. She and Winnie McBroom, owner of Winnie's Fine Fashions,

hatched the idea for the annual Olde Tyme Apple Festival in 1979, which still thrives today.

Donna was the proud grandmother of Jared Witt, Alyssa Garber, Taylor Timmons, Emily Timmons, Marisa Pummer and Jason Pummer. She kept the family close, planning annual Thanksgiving trips that spanned much of the United States. Donna's last few years were spent with Larry living near family in Columbus, Georgia.

A service will be held at Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home in Versailles on Friday, April 11th. Visitation will start at 10:00 a.m. with the service following at 11:00 a.m. In lieu of flowers, the family welcomes donations in her name to either Morgan County Caring for Kids Coalition or Food for Morgan County.

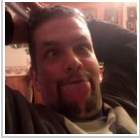
