Donna Sue Slagle, age 76, of Versailles, passed away Monday, August 26, 2013, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. She was born February 12, 1937, in Fortuna, Missouri, a daughter of the late Edgar and Mary Josephine (Hamilton) Hutchison.
