Dorothy Marie Chapman, age 94, of Versailles, passed away Thursday, November 3, 2016, at the Golden Age Living Center in Stover. She was born August 5, 1922, in Barnett, Missouri, the daughter of the late Kenneth Alto “Pete” and Gladys Marie (Eagle) Goodman.
