### DOROTHY HARLEMAN

Dorothy Ellen Harleman, 93, of Versailles, Missouri, passed away Saturday, January 28, 2017 in Bothwell Regional Health Center, Sedalia, Missouri. She was born October 12, 1923 in Florence, Missouri, a daughter of Oscar Edward and Dorothy Allie (Hodges) White.

On July 11, 1947, she was united in marriage to Arthur Clyde "Mack" Harleman. Together they shared thirty-six years of marriage before his passing on November 5, 1983.

She was also preceded in death by her parents; three brothers, Nathaniel, Phillip and Almon White and two sisters, Betty Brown and Helen Lothrop.

She was an animal lover and had a knack for growing house plants.

She was a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Sedalia, where she played the piano and organ for years.

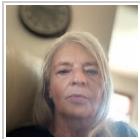

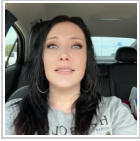
