



## Dustin Allen Miller

January 11, 1971 - February 25, 2025

Dustin Allen Miller, age 54, of Laurie, passed away Tuesday, February 25, 2025, at his home from natural causes. He was born January 11, 1971, in Alva, Oklahoma, the son of John Gerald “Jerry” and Jan (Grosvenor) Miller.

He graduated from Sweet Springs High School in 1989. He enlisted in the United States Navy in October of 1994. He served as an Aircraft Carrier Flight Deck Chief, Night Aircraft Handling Officer, Helicopter Control Tower Officer and a Safety Officer. He led flight deck teams on various ships and was awarded four Commendation Medals, thirty-five Achievement Medals, four Military Outstanding Volunteer Service medals and various other accomplishments. Dustin served in Operation Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. He retired in April of 2017 with the rank of Chief Petty Officer. Following his retirement from the military, he was employed at AB Pest Control as a pest control service technician.

Dustin enjoyed spending time playing golf, bowling, playing pool and going to the casino and playing craps. He loved living at the Lake of the Ozarks where he spent time on the water, boating. He was an avid F1 fan and football fan, always cheering for his favorite team, the Kansas City Chiefs. Dustin loved life and the lifelong friendships he made while serving in the Navy. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.

He is survived by his mother, Jan Wyatt of Russellville, Missouri; his cat, Miss Kitten; aunt, Patti Winslow of Seattle, Washington; uncle, Robby Grosvenor of Belle, Missouri; several nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends. He was preceded in death by his father, Jerry Miller and his grandparents.

A celebration of Dustin's life will be held at 11:00 a.m., Friday, March 14th, at St. Paul's Evangelical Church in Jamestown with Pastor Steve Watson officiating. The family will receive friends from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m., Friday, at the church. Graveside services and inurnment with full military honors will be held at 1:30 p.m., Friday, at the California City Cemetery.
