Earl Wayne Pipes, Sr., age 87, of Versailles, passed away Friday, April 25, 2025, at his home. He was born September 23, 1937, in Morgan County, a son of the late Glen Edwin and Nellie Gilberta (Sousley) Pipes.

On April 18, 1959, he was united in marriage to Mary Lou Patterson, who preceded him in death on January 11, 1997. Later, on May 19, 2001, he married his surviving wife, Jane (Collins) Pipes.

Earl proudly served his country in the United States Army from 1954 to 1957.
