Earl Lee Vogt, age 89, of Versailles, passed away Monday, April 25, 2011, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles after a long battle with Alzheimer's. He was born May 30, 1921, in Morgan County, Missouri, the son of the late Edward J. and Emma Mae Kreiling Vogt.

Earl was a United States Army veteran having served in WWII.
