Edgar H. Thiemann, age 90, of Versailles, passed away Thursday, September 22, 2011, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born April 18, 1921, near Pawnee City, Nebraska, the eighth of thirteen children of Ernest L. and Myrtle Neal Thiemann.

On September 15, 1943, in Seneca, Kansas, he was united in marriage to Opal Mae Forney, who survives at the Good Shepherd Care Center.

Edgar and family moved to Camdenton, Missouri, from Pawnee City, in 1952, where Ed operated his own ceramic tile and floor covering business. Ed and his sons worked all around the Lake of the Ozarks.
