June 18, 1920 - August 12, 2014

Eliese Dolores Itzel Brown, age 94, of Laurie, passed away Tuesday, August 12, 2014, at Lake Regional Health System in Osage Beach. She was born June 18, 1920, in Baltimore, Maryland, the daughter of the late George A. and Margaret R. (Faulk) Itzel.
