Ervin H. Krewson, age 78, of Stover, passed away Friday evening, June 24, 2011, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. He was born September 5, 1932, in Clinton, Missouri, the son of the late C. Virgil and Lena Stewart Krewson.

He retired from Bendix as a supervisor after 34 ½ years of service.

Ervin was a United States Navy veteran having served in the Korean Conflict.

He was past commander of the American Legion Post 596 in Raytown. He was also a member of the American Legion Zack Wheat Post 624 in Sunrise Beach, the Versailles Masonic Lodge 320 A.F. & A.M., and the Ararat Shrine in Kansas City, Missouri.
